The Property Log Book is a web-based service so has no impact on your IT

The PLB stays with the property forever and no more worrying about lost information.

The PLB is an on-line tool for people to access their property information 24/7.

When a buyer, or tenant, moves into their home, they are given their own unique access to their PLB. Only they can access this ensuring compliance with data protection and GDPR.

An agency, developer or conveyancer will have a duplicate copy of a property's PLB, which is their record of all property information, up to point of sale.

Compliance

The PLB is compliant with the Code for Sustainable Homes and the Consumer Code for Home Builders and helps agents meet National Trading Standards information up-front requirements.

The PLB can also be used for energy and utilities monitoring as well as **smart metering**.


